

### “Unique Creation” Project Example

A unique creation is taking one existing creative “thing” - interpreting it in your own way - and presenting your own creation in a “unique way” in the form of another creative discipline.

**For Example:**

Take a “found” artistic object (i.e. a song, a poem, a dance or a painting, etc.) and RE-INTERPRET it into another creative medium (i.e. a song presented in response to a poem, a poem presented in response to a song, a painting presented in response to a dance, a performance piece presented in response to a news article, etc.).

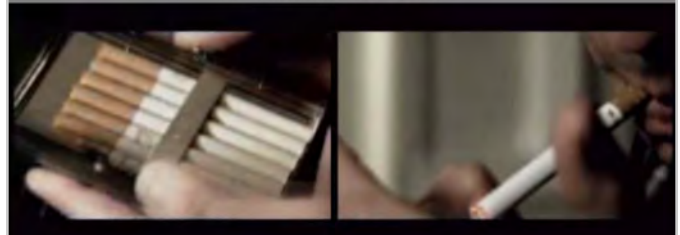

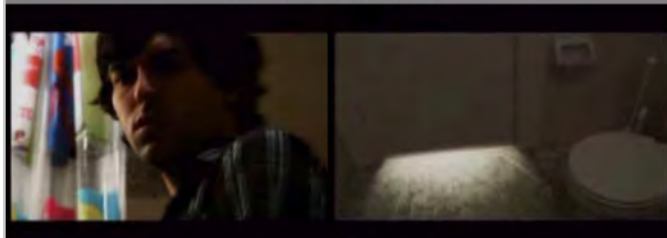

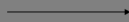
